- ❖ Support your child participating in camps with their Cub Pack between now and the event. It is recommended that they spend at least two nights under canvas beforehand to ensure that they can cope with the camp.

- All other attending Adults are to bring their own tents or are able to use swags. Please ask you Group for assistance if required.
- ◆ Parents (of attending Joeys) who also happen to be Joey Leaders must choose to attend the camp as either Joey Leader OR Parent.
- ♦ No swags for Joeys or Cubs please (all Joeys and Cubs must be inside a tent and swags will not fit).
- Siblings will not be allowed to attend this camp unless they are Scouting members.
- ♠ Parents should assist their Scout Group and Leaders with any fundraising activities planned for this camp.
- Parents would normally assist in a variety of positions such as cooks, kitchen hands, supervising youth or assisting at the activity sites. Whatever the job you decide to help with, you will still receive a chance to 'watch' your child in action for a time.
