SC 5 application process:

You will need your child's scouting membership number.

Complete the on-line application – print – sign – take it to your section leader with the revolution fee.

If for some reason you have trouble completing the on-line application, print it. Complete the hard copy - sign it - and ask your section leader to register you on-line at a later time.

Everybody attending ADF SC5 is required to complete an application form and there will be a 'NO form No Camp' policy. Ask your Section Leader should you experience any on-line difficulty.

The application forms are out soon however the Revolution price is not the end cost. There are a few hidden costs that most people do not see: extra cooler, ice, hats for our youth so we will be recommending a \$15 extra per person surcharge to cover this cost. Your group may also have a travelling cost component to consider as well. Fundraising is a great way to offset these charges.



Joeys will be required to have their parents with them at all times.

While the Joeys are participating within each of the activities the Joey parents will be asked to either assist with supervision or assist in running a small activity. Joey Parents will need to check with the Group Leader but may be asked to bring their own tent.



Cub Parents available positions (Cooks, kitchen hands, working activity site helpers).

All Cub Parents assigned to a position will have structured time off to watch their child in action. Cubs will need to sleep with their Pack and not with their parents. Cub parents may bring swags or their own tent or be assigned a tent by their Section Leader.
