Joeys will be required to have their parents with them at all times. Although the Joey parents will be with the Joeys at all times they will also be available and asked to assist with supervision at each of the different activities sites.

Cub Parents will be general camp helpers (Cooks, kitchen hands, off-site helpers). All Cub Parents assigned to a position will have structured time to visit the activities to watch their child in action.

You are aware if a parent is helping out within the youth section once in a while then no NPC is required. However if that parent is helping out quite a few times then it is advisable to ask for a NPC to be completed. Parents are not required to complete an NPC for this camp however if you plan to place a parent in a key position in charge of youth then maybe you could be preparing for that now.

Leaders will be in-charge of the youth as much as possible:

Leaders will hold key positions of responsibility. The camp structure is designed to offer maximum support for both youth and adults throughout the duration of the sub-camp. All positions will have a job title as well as a job description. We have in place risk assessment, operational plans, policies and everyone will know before the camp what they are doing and the parameters of that job.

We feel we can offer bulk buying and our Catering Manager Graham is hot on that trail:

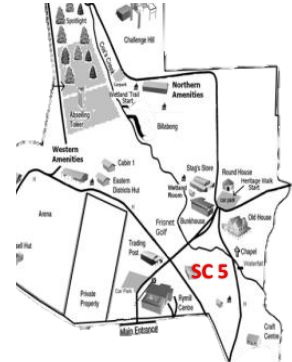
